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Jesus is the Bread of Life

Read John 6:25-59

Icebreaker: What is your favourite food? Why is it your favourite?

- Read the passage and make any interesting observations.
- Who is Jesus speaking to?
- What were they looking for?
- What do you remember about Manna?
- Why did the Jews grumble?
- Describe in your own words what Jesus's 'bread' is.

General

- What promises does Jesus make in this passage? Share with each other if you gain any encouragement from them.
- Will we really never be hungry or thirsty again after eating the Bread of God?
- Who has God 'given' to Jesus? What will happen to them?
- What elements of Jesus's teaching did the Jews not understand?

Deeper

- v27. 'Do not work for food that spoils, but for the food that endures to eternal life'. How can we apply this to upcoming week? What is exactly is work that endures to eternal life?

Mission

- Consider a memory verse from any of the passages this week and commit to learning it. Be prepared to be quizzed next week!

Activity

Jesus is the Holy One

Read John 6:60-71

Icebreaker: What do you find is the hardest of Jesus's teachings to accept? Share with the group experiences.

- Read the passage and make any interesting highlights.
- Who is involved in the conversation?
- Recount some key points of Jesus's teachings from the previous passage. Why did 'many of his disciples' turn back?
- What does it say about their faith?

- Explain what vv61-62 means?
- What does it mean when Jesus affirms from the previous passage that 'no one can come to me unless the Father has enabled them'? Does this we have been 'enabled'?

Deeper

- Why do you think Jesus asked the Twelve if they wanted to leave too if He already knew the answer (being omniscient)?
- Explain v70. Was Judas already a 'devil'? How does this fit with John 13:27? Why did Jesus choose him?

Mission

- What has been something you've been struggling with recently? Any worries, addictions, or attitudes that you are willing to share with each other? Pray for one another regarding these things.

Activity

- Consider a memory verse from any of the passages this week and commit to learning it. Be prepared to be quizzed next week!

Jesus is Freedom



Read John 8:31-47

Icebreaker: Do slaves still exist in the world? What do you know about the situations of slavery in different countries?

- Describe the setting of this passage. What disputes have occurred?

General

- What truth bombs has Jesus dropped on the Jews?
- How did the Jews react?
- How is someone 'set free' according to Jesus?
- What claims does Jesus make of Himself?

- What elements of Jesus's teachings did they not understand?
- In v37, Jesus acknowledges that the Jews are 'descendants' of Abraham, yet challenges it in v39. Is there a difference between being a 'descendant' and a 'child'? Is there a passage you know that can shed light on this?
- What does Jesus mean 'then you would do what Abraham did.' What should the Jews have done?
- What does it mean to 'belong to God'? Why do the Jews not belong to God?

Deeper

- Is there anything you need to be set free from? Pray about it with your group.
- Who are some people you can share the truth with this week?

Mission

Activity

- Consider a memory verse from any of the passages this week and commit to learning it. Be prepared to be quizzed next week!

Jesus is the 'I AM'



Read John 8:48-59

Icebreaker: What is the most out-of-character thing you've done in your life? Tell the story to your group.

- Read the passage and make any interesting observations.
- Who is Jesus speaking to?
- What happened in the previous passage?
- Why do the Jews call Jesus a 'Samaritan'?
- Will we really never see death? What does it mean?

General

Deeper

- What does it mean when Jesus uses the term I Am. How would the Jews have understood this term? (Exodus 3)
- Explain your understanding of Jesus's glory.
- Relating to v56, What promises or prophecies did God make to Abraham regarding Jesus?
- Have you ever questioned Jesus's claims or who He is? What conclusions or issues did you end up with?

Mission

- How can you give encouragement to the people around you this week?
- What does it mean to obey Jesus's word? How can you live this out more and more?

Activity

- Jesus has been called many things (even in the past few passages alone): demon-possessed, liar, lunatic. Who do you say Jesus is _____?
- Negotiate a memory verse from anywhere in the Bible to memorise. Be prepared to be quizzed next week!
